

Internet and E-mail Use Agreement

- Staff at Wallaroo Primary School will supervise on-line users and promote responsible and proper use of our on-line resources. Staff will not, however, be held responsible for inappropriate use of Internet and E-mail facilities.

Conditions of use

I, the student, agree to the following conditions of Internet and E-mail usage:

- I will use the Internet for school purposes only.
- I will not give out personal information such as my address, telephone number or the name of my school without my parents' permission.
- I will acknowledge all sources of downloaded information.
- I will not deliberately attempt to access web-sites that contain inappropriate material*.
- I will tell the teacher if I come across any information that makes me feel uncomfortable.
- If I see another student accessing inappropriate material, I will immediately inform the teacher.
- I will not attempt to send inappropriate E-mail messages; put downs, harassment etc.

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Internet and E-mail Use

- The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all users have **supervised, well supported access** to on-line resources at Wallaroo Primary School.
- It is our expectation that all users will operate in accordance with our school's educational goals and the regulations established by DETE and the State Government of South Australia. Safe use of the Internet, is taught and modeled at our school.
- All users are therefore responsible for their own behavior when using our on-line resources. Conditions of on-line use are set out in the accompanying document, titled "Wallaroo Primary School Internet and E-mail Use Agreement".
- Staff at Wallaroo Primary School will maintain vigilant supervision of on-line users, and promote responsible and proper use of our on-line resources
- Staff will not, however, be held responsible for the inappropriate use of the Internet and E-mail.

Internet and E-mail Use Policy

It is our policy to:

- Make on-line resources available to our educational community R-7 in the same way as we make print and multimedia resources available.
- Provide access to on-line resources.
- Assist students to use search engines/ indexes where appropriate.
- Encourage and develop responsible, accountable research behaviour.
- Skill staff at Wallaroo Primary School to provide advice about, support for and supervision of the use of our on-line resources.
- Skill staff at Wallaroo Primary School to teach and model effective and efficient on-line information searching techniques.
- Skill staff at Wallaroo Primary School to teach and model targeted and responsible E-mailing.
- Skill students at Wallaroo Primary School to use effective and efficient on-line information searching techniques.
- Skill Students at Wallaroo Primary School to use E-mail responsibly.

Consequences for Misuse.

I, the student, understand that inappropriate use of E-mail and internet will result in the following:

- Immediate removal from the Library or IT Room and no access for one week. Loss of IT Lab Licence.
- Parents will be informed of the inappropriate behaviour. A meeting with parents and school staff will be conducted.
- Loss of Internet use privileges for a period of time to be determined by the Principal.
- The possibility of suspension for any second offence, as part of our school's Behaviour Management Policy.
